



Construction Safety Training for February 2012

Safe Propane Handling Training

Next scheduled class in Cambridge is Tuesday, February 21st, 2012 (8:00am- 11:00am)

The Ontario regulations 211/01, 215/01, and the CSA Propane Storage and Handling Code B 149.2-00, requires all workers who handle, connect or operate propane fuelled appliances be properly trained. Propane training is to be updated every 3 years.

Natural Gas for Construction Heaters Training

Next scheduled class in Cambridge is Tuesday, February 21st, 2012 (12:00noon – 3:00pm)

Ontario TSSA Regulations. 212/01, 215/01 requires any worker who installs, connects, operates or handles natural gas construction heaters, to be properly trained. Regulations require natural gas training to be updated every 3 years.

WHMIS Training

Next scheduled class in Cambridge is Thursday, February 23rd, 2012 (8:00am - Noon)

The Occupational Health & Safety Act & Construction Regulations require all employees to be trained in WHMIS.

Fall Protection Training

Next scheduled class in Cambridge is Thursday, February 23rd, 2012 (1:00pm – 4:30pm)

Regulation 213/91 requires anyone exposed to a fall hazard to be trained in Fall Protection. This includes all supervisors, workers, and any site visitors (i.e. Arch., Eng., and Sales).

Green Book Training: (Occupational Health and Safety Act & Regulations for Construction)

Next scheduled class in Cambridge is Thursday, March 1st, 2012 (8:00am-4:30pm)

Excellent for anyone who has a responsibility under the Occupational Health & Safety Act, especially project managers, supervisors, and company owners.

We explore the 10 parts of the act, including responsibilities of the parties, fines, powers of the inspector, as well as many other topics. We also explore the different parts of the Construction Regulations.

Did you know **under the newly passed bill C-45 it has become a criminal offence** if you intentionally neglect your duties under the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations for Construction?
